Top Tips for Successful On-Line Learning

1) Log in to EVERY class, EVERY day

You must be in class every Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday. You must complete your assignments during schooltime. Teachers must see your lovely face for attendance to count! Make sure you are ON TIME to log in.



2) Manage Your Time

Do not wait--if you have time, get assignments done. On Wednesdays, you will be working on your own. Make a list of what you need to do and check it off as you go. You also will have some extended projects. Make sure you work on projects a little every day to meet the deadlines.



3) Be organized

Make sure you have what you need for classes, such as a book for language arts and paper and pencil for working math problems. Keep all of your school supplies together in one place in your home.

4) Eliminate distractions

Try to find a quiet place in your home to work. Please turn off the TV, put your cell phone away, and close all other windows on your computer. No social media or video games during school hours so that you can focus on learning!



5) Communicate with your teacher

Ask lots of questions! If you are having problems with your computer or with connecting, let your teacher know. Don't be afraid to ask for help. We want to help you!

6) Use On-Line Manners

Mute your microphone so that there isn't feedback and distractions for others. Arrange your computer so that there is a wall behind you to keep your family's privacy. Make sure your face is in the light. Keep the video on if you can, but communicate with your teacher if you need to turn off the video.

7) Interact with the teacher

Show your teacher that you are paying attention and are learning by showing facial expressions, using thumbs up, silent claps, etc.. Students who interact with the teacher and the class will learn more!
